Where the two lines cross — that's you. Mark the dot.

**Progressive** (left) — personal freedom high, economic freedom lower

**Conservative** (right) — economic freedom high, personal freedom lower

**Authoritarian** (bottom) — favors government action on both fronts

**Moderate** (centre) — a case-by-case mix of all of the above
